Excess

You will have to contribute an Excess(es) to any claim under this Policy. The standard Excesses are shown in Standard Excesses – Table 1. Any additional Excesses are shown in Additional Excesses – Tables 2 and 3.

Any **Excess(es)** shown on **Your Schedule** will prevail over the applicable **Excesses** in Tables 1, 2 and 3.

Part B: Changes to the PDS which apply to new policies and renewals from 1 June 2024

General Definitions

In the Policy Wording section, on page 15, under the heading 'General Definitions', the following definition of Mobile Plant is inserted:

Mobile Plant means any mobile or self-propelled machinery or equipment including its associated tools, fittings and accessories, that is not a **Vehicle** designed for the transportation of people or goods on public roads or thoroughfares.

It also includes any associated attachment on Your Mobile Plant that is:

- (a) described in Your Schedule; or
- (b) is permanently attached to the Mobile Plant.

Mobile Plant does not include equipment, machinery or any other apparatus attached to **Your Vehicle**.

In the Policy Wording section, on page 15, under the heading 'General Definitions', the Tool of Trade definition is deleted and replaced with:

Tool of Trade means any of the following when being used at the time of the **Accident** for the purpose for which the **Tool of Trade** was designed:

- Mobile Plant; or
- plant or equipment permanently attached to **Your Vehicle** that is used for digging, cutting, fine scraping, grading, slashing, mowing, drilling, pumping, lifting or levelling.



Other than as set out above, all other policy terms, conditions, limits and exclusions remain unchanged.
